

#### INTRODUCTION TO THE CANDLE-LIGHTING

After receiving the bread, proceed to the communion assistant, staying on the same side as you are seated in the church, to receive the wine. For those who would prefer not to have wine, pre-filled cups of grape juice are available on each side in silver trays.

Return to your seat by way of the side ramp. Please pick up a communion card from the basket at the bottom of the ramp Please complete the card and place it in the plate in the Narthex after worship.


