

were sown, that we may be fed with the bread of life. Gather the hopes and the dreams of all; unite them with


the prayers we offer now. Grace our table with your presence, and give us a foretaste of the feast to come.

## \*THE LORD'S PRAYER


Our Father, who art in heaven,
